- 4. Have you ever struggled mightily for something and succeeded? What made you successful?
- 5. Have you ever struggle mightily for something and failed? How did you respond? Have you experienced a feeling of disappointment and dissatisfaction of yourself? (2017-IM-KCFCU Scholarship)
- 6. Have you experienced a moment of epiphany, as if your eyes were opened to something you were previously blind to?
- 7. What is your strongest, most unwavering personality trait? Do you maintain strong beliefs or adhere to a philosophy? How would your friends characterize you? What would they write about if they were writing a scholarship essay for you?
- 8. What have you done outside of the classroom that demonstrates qualities sought after by universities? Of these, which one(s) mean the most to you?
- 9. What are your most important extracurricular or community activities? What made you join these activities? What made you continue to contribute to them?
