Writing Reminders for Essays about Literature Expository Writing

- 1. Identify Title and Author of Story/Poem
- 2. Restate the Prompt in a Declarative Sentence
- 3. Provide specific examples/quotes from the story
- 4. Cite the page number of your quote (73).
- 5. End with a "clincher" sentence
- 6. Stay in Present Tense ("is")
- 7. Revise your sentences; include transition words (however, therefore, for example, another example /reason, because, although...)
- 8. Revise for Word Choice (Diction)
- 9. Edit your essay: there/their, commas, apostrophes
